## About Escort XP

Primarily used as a post-emergent herbicide across the United States, Escort XP cost-effectively controls many annual and perennial weeds, plus tough woody plants. Selective to many grasses, Escort XP is known for its low use rates and flexible application timing. Symptoms can often be seen in as little as 2-4 weeks.

## Application and use

- // Escort XP is a dry flowable that is mixed in water and applied as a spray
- // Controls annual and perennial weeds, plus unwanted woody plants on:
  - Rights-of-way
  - Industrial sites
  - Non-crop areas
  - Types of unimproved industrial turfgrass
  - Conifer and hardwood plantations

## Application tips

- // For best control of annual weeds, apply to young, actively-growing weeds
- // For best control of perennial weeds, apply:
  - At the bud/bloom stage in spring
  - Or during the rosette stage in fall
- // Warm, moist conditions enhance effectiveness
- // Apply using aerial or ground equipment
- // Can be used year-round on some warm-season grasses

- // Applied at a low use rate – reducing the chemical load on treated acres without compromising weed control
- // Dry flowable process – offers better solubility in the tank and more uniform spray coverage
